## Message from the Headteacher

This week we have seen 74 children return to school and although our numbers remain much reduced it is lovely to see smiling faces coming through the gate in the morning. I know that the children in school have enjoyed being here and we have a small number returning next week. Unfortunately we are now full in both the Year 1 and Reception bubbles and therefore cannot offer spaces to any further children in those year groups for the time being. The number of children we are able to safely accommodate is determined by the government guidance around maximum pupil numbers in the group and the size of the classroom in order to ensure social distancing measures remain in place. There remains a limited number of spaces in Year 6 and the Key worker groups. We have a waiting list for these groups in the office but please be aware that the expectation is that children are now expected to be in school each day.

We will continue to provide home learning packs for all year groups and you will soon be receiving the next pack which will have three weeks' worth of learning within them. With the next home learning pack there will be a pack of transition work for children to complete during the week commencing 13<sup>th</sup> July. This transition pack will be set by the new year group team that your child will be transitioning into. We will be in a position to announce class teachers nearer to this time and will do so via ParentMail. We will also be arranging some contact during this week between children and their new teachers. More details will follow about this.

As we are reaching capacity in school and following the government announcement of Years 2 to 5 not returning to school this side of the summer break, our teachers are very much looking forward to you joining them on both Class Dojo and PurpleMash; where they have been maintaining contact with children through reading stories, sending messages and giving feedback on work. It has been lovely to see children engaging with their teachers through Class Dojo and we know that teachers have been busy producing videos and activities to upload to their class areas.

Please use the log in details that you were sent with Home Learning pack 4 to access both Class Dojo and Purple Mash because these are now an important part of our home schooling offer, so if you have not yet logged onto these platforms, please do so. If you need help top access either Class Dojo or Purple Mash, please contact the school office.
