Dear Parent/Carer

As you are aware, we are working hard to keep the school open throughout this national lockdown. In order to help us with this I would like to ask you to remember the following points which are crucial to the ongoing health of everyone in the building.

- If you or anyone in your household develops symptoms of COVID-19 – a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a sudden loss of taste or smell – you must keep your children at home and seek a test immediately.
- If you or anyone in your household is being tested, even if you are asymptomatic, you must keep your children at home until you have received the result. If the result is negative, the children may return to school. If the result is positive you must self isolate as a family and follow the advice of track and trace. Family members who do not develop symptoms will be advised to self-isolate for 10 days.

We are regularly reviewing our risk assessment to ensure that we are responding effectively to the ever changing challenges that this pandemic presents and appreciate the support you are able to give us with this.
