Message from the Assistant Headteacher

Dear Parents and Carers,

It is hard to believe that it is May half term already. Thank you to all parents and carers who have completed the survey sent out earlier this week in anticipation of welcoming some of our pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 back into school on 1st June. You should now have a confirmation letter outlining how the school day will be organised. Health and safety of your child and our staff is paramount at Lime Academy Watergall. We have assessed the size of our classrooms, routes in and out of classrooms, how transitions work and how we can support the health and wellbeing of our pupils. The Government will be confirming whether this will be happening by the 29th May so please do keep an eye on the daily briefings. If the reopening is delayed from 1st June we will contact you via Parentmail. Children may benefit from getting themselves back into a routine before school reintegration starts. This may include getting up early in the morning and re-establishing a good bedtime routine so that when school restarts this is less of an adjustment to make.

If your child is in these year groups, and you have not yet informed school that your child will be returning to school, please do not send your child into school on 1st June but complete the recent parent survey that was emailed out to you on Wednesday. This is so that we can make the necessary preparations for your child's safe return to school. Children in other year groups will remain at home until we are advised by the government, but they will continue to receive home learning packs set by their class teacher.

I trust that you and your families are safe and well. We are hoping that we are beginning to see the light at the end of the tunnel and that over time, when it is safe to do, there will be a return to a sense of normality. It has been a pleasure during these challenging times to speak to many of our children and parents through telephone contact that has been made and to hear of how you have found the positive out of a negative situation.

Could I also take this opportunity to thank all our fantastic staff for their hard work and flexibility throughout these unusual times. I hope parents and carers will join me in showing appreciation to each and every one of them as they have truly gone above and beyond to support our school, children and their families during this coronavirus outbreak.

I hope that the weather continues to shine this coming week and that you manage to get out and enjoy it!
