

Message from the Headteacher:

We have had a very productive week in school this week and it has been lovely to see the children getting back into learning. This week we have started the new Lime Trust curriculum and the children have been learning new approaches across the curriculum. In English lessons, each year group have started to read the focus text for this half term and I hope that your child will be able to talk to you about that text.

Year 3, 4 and 5 were able to enjoy a live production of The Wizard of Oz this week. The theatre company have worked very hard to create a production that is both safe and engaging, through the use of pre-recorded scenes narrated by a single actor. Each year group were able to watch the production separately and thoroughly enjoyed the experience. The company are revisiting us in December in order to give Years 1, 2 and 6 the opportunity to experience some live theatre.
